REGULAR MEETING
July 27, 2015

The Vice President of the Board, Jeff Maze called the meeting to order at 7PM in the District Office. Roll call showed the following people present: Jeff Maze, Michael Cloud, Scott Patterson, Judy Billingsley, Mark Shumake, and Brad Trovillion. Steve Benard was absent.

No one was present to address the Board during Public Hearings and Petitions.

Motion by Mark Shumake, and seconded by Judy Billingsley, the Board voted to accept the consent agenda items including: minutes of the regular meeting, and closed session minutes on June 29, 2015, payroll and district bills, and school district financial reports. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Michael Cloud, and seconded by Scott Patterson, the Board voted to approve the Title I E-Plan Revision as proposed. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Judy Billingsley, and seconded by Scott Patterson, the Board voted to approve the necessary bids for food service. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Judy Billingsley, and seconded by Mark Shumake, the Board voted to go into closed session at 7:06PM to confidentially discuss information regarding the employment of specific employees and the semi-annual review of closed meeting minutes and audio recordings. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Scott Patterson, and seconded by Judy Billingsley, the Board voted to reconvene the regular meeting at 8:03PM. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea, no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Mark Shumake, and seconded by Michael Cloud the Board voted to destroy all audio tapes more than 5 years old and keep all Closed Session minutes closed. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Brad Trovillion, and seconded by Michael Cloud, the Board voted to recall Brandilyn Klope for the 3/7 Pre-K Teacher position. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Mark Shumake, and seconded by Scott Patterson, the Board voted to we reassign, per her request, Jennifer Ingram to 1 FTE English Teacher for the 2015-2016 school year as proposed. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Scott Patterson, and seconded by Judy Billingsley, the Board voted to employ Kasandra Moss as part-time (2/7) English Teacher for the 2015-2016 school year as proposed. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Mark Shumake, and seconded by Judy Billingsley, the Board voted to employ Treca McConnell as part-time (2/7) CNA Program Instructor for the 2015-2016 school year as proposed. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Scott Patterson, and seconded by Michael Cloud, the Board voted to we accept the resignation of Kim Miller as School Nurse effective immediately. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Scott Patterson, and seconded by Brad Trovillion, the Board voted to employ Treca McConnell as 1 FTE (8 Hour) School Nurse for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Mark Shumake, and seconded by Michael Cloud, the Board voted to employ Kasandra Moss as a 5/7 Part-Time Special Education Paraprofessional for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Judy Billingsley, and seconded by Brad Trovillion, the Board voted to employ Brittany Runge as a Special Education Paraprofessional for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Judy Billingsley, and seconded by Jeff Maze, the Board voted to employ Judy White as an at-will Individual Aide for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Brad Trovillion, and seconded by Michael Cloud, the Board voted to employ Brenda Bradford as an at-will Individual Aide for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Mark Shumake, and seconded by Brad Trovillion, the Board voted to employ Ali Buffington as an at-will Individual Aide for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Judy Billingsley, and seconded by Scott Patterson, the Board voted to employ Chris Powell as a part-time (5 hour) 180 day night custodian for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Brad Trovillion, and seconded by Judy Billingsley, the Board voted to employ Rhonda Maze as a 5.5 hour cook/cashier for the 2015-2015 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Jeff Maze, and seconded by Brad Trovillion, the Board voted to accept the resignation of Jenny Clark as Pre-K Paraprofessional effective immediately. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Judy Billingsley, and seconded by Scott Patterson, the Board voted to employ Brock Babbington as High School Boys Junior Varsity/Assistant Basketball Coach for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Mark Shumake, and seconded by Brad Trovillion, the Board voted to employ Bradley Griffith as High School Boys Freshman Basketball Coach for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Brad Trovillion, and seconded by Michael Cloud, the Board voted to employ Heather Goelz as High School Girls Junior Varsity/Assistant Volleyball Coach for the 2015-2016 school year. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Motion by Michael Cloud, and seconded by Scott Patterson, the Board voted to approve the recycling contract as proposed. On a roll call vote: Maze, Cloud, Patterson, Billingsley, Shumake, and Trovillion voted yea; no nays and the motion carried.

Informational Items:

Principal Miller and Principal King gave their report, which included the following:

1. Registration went very smooth. Tentative numbers of those who are registered: we have registered 25 new students. There are about 60 students who have not registered yet, however, most are believed to still be in the district. We know of 5 so far who have moved out of the district. No new special education students have registered as of today.
2. School begins Aug. 12th and students will attend a full day. Teacher in-service is on Aug. 11th. There will be a K-12 Open House on the night of the 11th from 6-7:30 p.m. Kindergarten orientation will begin at 5:00.
3. Janitors are working hard to put the school back together! Everything is looking really good!
4. 32 Teachers attended the Google Classroom training presented by Mr. Helton. All comments were positive!
5. We are in the process of setting up the Chromebooks with the security tag and getting them ready for distribution.
6. The new 411 school messenger system is in place. Email communication has been added to the system this year.
