## 2019-20 K-12 Registration

Registration will be held in the Goreville High School gym on *Thursday, July 11th from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.* Registration forms have been included for each student. Please complete and return on registration day. It is very important that ALL information be completely filled out on ALL FORMS. Some requested information has changed for the 19-20 school year. Please note that we need a current email address for every household.

**Proof of residency MUST be shown for ALL NEW STUDENTS, OR THOSE WHO HAVE A CHANGED ADDRESS, in the district for the 19-20 school year.** An affidavit of residency is required for all students. (this form is included with this mailing). In order to prove residence, you need to choose 1: property tax bill, mortgage papers for homeowners, signed and dated lease and proof of last month's payment, letter from manager and proof of landlord in lieu of lease, OR, if you wish, you may choose 3 of the following to show proof of residency: driver's license, vehicle registration, voter registration, most recent cable television and/or credit card bill, current public aid card, current homeowners/renters insurance policy and premium payment receipt, most recent gas, electric, and/or water bill, current library card, receipt for moving van rental, or mail received at new residence.

- During registration, any student who needs to sign up for a bus assignment will do so then. Even if your child is a bus rider from previous years, you will need to speak with the bus supervisor because the routes may have changed from last year.
- Parents will be able to deposit money into their student's lunch account for the beginning of the year.
- Any high school student who hasn't signed up for classes will be able to meet with the Guidance Counselor at registration.
- All students in grade 6-12 will be assigned a locker on registration day. You must be assigned a locker before you can put a lock on it. If you do not have a school lock, you can get one at registration. Any student who was issued a school lock last year, and doesn't bring it to school for this school year, will have to pay a \$5.00 fee for a new one. Any student who needs to purchase a lock for their locker can do so during registration. Locks purchased outside of school will NOT be allowed.
- At registration, students will receive their classroom/homeroom assignments. Any new students registering will be assigned to a class on registration day.
- Any student owing money for previous years in the form of outstanding fees, lost library books, locks, damaged text books, uniforms, or outstanding lunch fees will be required to pay the balance at registration.
- Assigned parking spots will be given out the first week of classes.
- Physical Education uniforms will be required for all students in jr. high and high school. Information about these uniforms will be passed out during the first week of the P.E. classes by both jr. high and h.s. Physical Education teachers.
- All students in grades first through twelfth will be issued an assignment book through the school. These will be handed out to students on the first full day of classes, therefore, there will be no need to purchase one at registration. If a student needs to replace an assignment book, the cost will be \$5.00.
- School supply lists will be available at registration, as well as on our website.
- **ALL STUDENTS IN GRADE 9-12, WHO ATTEND REGISTRATION, WILL BE ISSUED A NEW CHROMEBOOK! STUDENTS MUST BE PRESENT TO TAKE HOME THE CHROMEBOOK.**

WE WILL NOT TAKE ANY EARLY REGISTRATIONS BEFORE JULY 11TH.  
ALL STUDENTS NEED TO BE REGISTERED BY AUGUST 5th!!

# Physical exams and immunizations

According to the statutes of the State of Illinois, immunizations and physical exams as prescribed by the Department of Public Health shall be required for ALL students. Physical exams must occur upon enrollment in:

1. Kindergarten or First Grade, sixth grade, and ninth grade
2. Immediately prior to or upon any entrance into any school if the student has not previously been examined or immunized in accordance with statutes.
